1. Pr. Bill opened the meeting with prayer.
2. We discussed what we want to see happen at our campus this following season. Mike – still working on a Multi-Generational VBS; Deb, Saturday service wants to retain the Heartland until Advent and then use the Holden Evening Prayer; otherwise business as usual.
3. Pr. Bill reported that the projection system and the digital sound system are both up and working. Volunteers will be needed to operate each. Tim will do the soundboard training. Also the youth will be conducting a pancake breakfast on Oct. 8th. This is fundraiser for their Youth Gathering in Houston in 2018. The youth group has decided to contribute their noisy offering to the Young Adult in Global Mission project.
7. Robert sent a report that the AC system is still running well. The storage bins for landscaping and yard tools have been received. This cleared out the storage room quite a bit.

Family Promise – Robin - Open dates in 2018 for Family Promise were discussed. Robin will present the finalized list to the Family Promise organizers for consideration. Sixteen air mattresses have arrived. An appropriate space needs to be found to store the mattresses. A meeting for Family Promise volunteers will be held in the Chapel on Monday, October 16th, at 5:30P.M.

I-Help- Linda distributed the I-Help Calendar for 2018. A new refrigerator was obtained from Habitat for Humanity. Gift bags containing a variety of useful items have been donated to the I-Help ladies.

Pastor Bill reported that the installation of projection equipment at Gold Canyon is complete and was used on Sunday, October 8th. Two donated TVs will be installed in the EM Narthex next week. 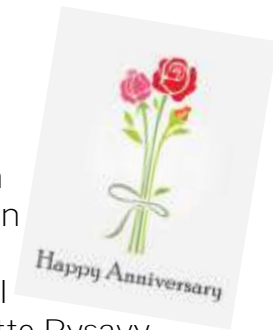
