Call to Order: Ron Rock called the Council meeting to order. Motion to accept agenda passed.

Devotions: Pr. Bill gave the devotion.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes from the November 1st special Council Meeting were approved as corrected. The minutes from the November regular Council Meeting were approved.

**Treasurer's Report:** Motion made and approved to accept the Treasurer's Report. Work is being done for the 2018 Mission Plan.

### **Pastor's Reports:**

Pr. Bill – All is in place for the Christmas services. He will be attending a continuing education seminar at **Luther Seminary on Science and Religion January 23rd through January 27th. If the new web site isn't up** right now, it should be very soon. There were some problems with the picture signups at Gold Canyon.

Pr. Tina— is staying at the Gold Canyon Campus Tuesday after Bible study and Thursdays after Gold Dusters. This gives a pastoral presence on a regular basis. The Care Ministry is going well. Home communion is seeing larger numbers. Family Promise will be back in March.

Kim McCracken reported that the Youth and Family programs are growing. The youth presented their Christmas program at Gold Canyon Dec. 17th. It was a great success. The program will be repeated on Dec 24th at East Mesa. The Angel Tree services 220 children this year.

V.P. Report: Stan Lehman is repurposing two brass candleholders no longer in use at East Mesa. They will be placed in use at the Gold Canyon campus.

Administration Report: Sharon Stinard reported Dave has been keeping busy with the maintenance of both campuses. A bid is being secured for more LED lights in the East Mesa parking lot. They are looking for an additional grant to help pay for this project. A new cleaning service will start at East Mesa in January. This new contract should save \$400 to \$500 a month.

East Mesa Coordinating Committee: Cindy Reichert has provided a written report and had no additions.

Gold Canyon Coordinating Committee: Janice Cunningham presented a written report. Suzy Cavoto informed us that Bev Taylor will be giving a report on her trip to Germany during the Forum time on Jan 28th.

Evangelism: Ruthie Beutel said there has been advertising in the East Valley Tribune and Independent with our Christmas hours. The barbershop concert was a huge success on Dec 17th. It was standing room only. One new member was recognized at Gold Canyon and 5 new ones at East Mesa. Jackie Rothbard is working on a new family directory.

Missions: Richard Faulk provided a written report.

Call Committee Report: Richard Faulk reported the Call Committee is moving ahead at a good pace.

Old Business: Pr. Bill reported that approximately \$8,000 was donated to the purchase of a new sign for East Mesa.

Council Actions Required: The Council has requested that Ron Rock submit an application to the Endowment Committee for a donation of \$10,000 toward the purchase of a new sign for East Mesa and \$14,000 for the projection project also for East Mesa.

New Business: There was no new business.

## East Mesa Coordinating Committee Minutes

The East Mesa Coordinating Committee met December 11, 2017 at 7:00 P.M.

Attending: Pastor Bill, Pastor Tina, Ron Rock, Robin Tomlinson, Ruthie Beutel, Kim McCracken, Richard Falk & Cindy Reichert.

Absent: Sharon Stinard, Stan Lehman, John Weber, Susan Drane, Dave Reurink, Linda Gerke, Ed Henderson, & Mike Kraklow

Pastor Bill opened with prayer.

Family Promise – Robin 5 families were welcomed the week of November 12th. All went well.

The families felt very comfortable and expressed their appreciation. There is adequate bedding to accommodate 16 family members. Funds received from Thrivent can be used for various needs. A permanent basketball hoop was mentioned as a possibility for the use of the funds, since this could also benefit the youth and young adults of the congregation. For safety reasons, there is a need for locks on cabinet doors in the room used has bedrooms for the families.

The next Family Promise event will take place the 3rd week of March.

Pastor Bill gave an update on the status of the microphone and sound systems at East Mesa and Gold Canyon. **The projects are nearing completion; however, the sound cabinet at East Mesa won't be completed until mid January.** Education pertaining to the hearing assisted devices will be needed.

An electronic sign will be set up for demonstration purposes on Sunday, December 17th from 7AM to 10:30 AM. This will allow the congregation to experience the capabilities of an electronic sign similar to those located at Broadway Christian Church and Love of Christ Lutheran.

LED Lighting Project – Dodge Electric will bid the cost to complete unfinished items.

Evangelism & Welcome – Ruthie Christmas services will be advertised in two publications; the Mesa Tribune section of the AZ Republic (3 times) and the Independent ( 1 direct mailing on Wednesday,

December 20.)The program for the Sunday, December 17th performance of the East Valley Harmonizers Barbershop Chorus will include an invitation and schedule for all OSLC Christmas services at both campuses. Five new members will be joining the weekend of December 16-17. Everything is in place for the 2018 Church Directory. Sign up sheets and literature are located in the Narthex and Fellowship Hall/Overflow areas at East Mesa.

Discipleship – Cindy – Luther books are in great demand. Books are ordered, but are arriving in small batches. Books will not be distributed until all have arrived.

Baptismal Festival is in the planning stages to provide baptismal opportunities for all interested members.

Sunday School & Youth – Kim – **The children's Christmas Program will be presented at Gold Canyon** on December 17th at 10:00 AM and at East Mesa at the 10:30 AM service on December 24th.

Fruit picking will begin on Saturday, January 13th.

A pancake dinner will be held on Tuesday, February 13 at Gold Canyon from 6-8 PM. There will be free will donation with proceeds going to the youth for the Youth Gathering to be held in Houston this summer.

A team is being formed to facilitate the maintenance and upkeep of the nursery area.

Missions- Richard – Quilts have been delivered to Concordia and Rockpoint. Thanks to the generosity **of the congregation, and the donated food obtained from the Girl Scouts' "Caroling for Cans" event, a large quantity of food shelf items have been collected and delivered.**
