God redeems that on which I've given up. God helps us get out of bed one more time, take one more step, risk helping another in love for another day.

The parts will keep moving... now I'm wondering if I'm one of God's moving parts... but that's a different story.

Pastor Bill opened with prayer.

Family Promise - Robin

The event held July 15-22 went smoothly. 4 adults and 14 children were our guests for the week. Next event will be held October 14-21.

I-Help – Linda

The storm on July 9th caused a power outage at the church for several days. I-Help women stayed at the church that evening; however, arrangements were made to house them at another location the next evening. An MOU approved by Council allows I-Help to utilize the Gold Canyon campus in the event of an emergency at the East Mesa location.

Pastor Bill

Engineering bids will be obtained in order to proceed with obtaining proper permits for the parking lot. Estimated cost for these services is in the \$14,000-\$22,000 range.
