May 13, 2019 EM Coordinating Committee (CC) Meeting Write up For Council Time: 7pm –8:20pm

Attending: Pastor Bill, Pastor Tina, Kim McCracken, Cindy Reichert, Linda Gerke, Phyllis Edmond, Robin Tomlinson, Ron Rock, Dave Reurink, Susan Drane, John Weber, and Mike Kraklow

Mike opened with prayer

Susan – Tomorrow, the personnel committee is interviewing two candidates for the Communication Coordinator position.

Robin – Family Promise – The next Family Promise event will be Sunday August 18th through Sunday August 25th.

Linda – I-Help – There was a request for volunteers on Tuesdays for I-Help that was put in the bulletin. Because of this Jackie and Gary Rothbard have volunteered. This is greatly appreciated. Ross has been a great help also. 14 cases of bottled water were delivered to Grace Lutheran this past weekend.

Phyllis – Kitchen – Phyllis will be getting some pots. This is within the scope of the kitchen supplies budget and will be purchased. Phyllis asked if there was going to be a special Memorial service. No there is not.

Ron – A meeting will be held on May 23rd to see if a variance will be approved to accept the existing parking lot lighting, current parking configuration, and to allow no fence along Weir Street.

Dave – Property – **The status of the “to do” list is as follows: The East entry lights have been fixed.** Dave has submitted to Home Security a bid for \$70,000 for new locks throughout the Church and is waiting for a response. The barrier to prevent climbers getting onto the roof from the south side is put on hold because of the cost. There are three options for child-safe curtains for the nursery. All options are very expensive. Dave will check out prices on putting one way mirror coating on the nursery windows. It is critical for safety of the people in the church to not to prop doors open and to keep the interior door from the office to the Sunday school hall closed.

Kim – Children, Youth and Family & Discipleship – We will be scheduling a screening for **the John Light Movie in January. A Women’s AA Group is interested in meeting out at Gold Canyon** on Wednesdays and Saturdays. Another HOA is interested in meeting at Gold Canyon on Tuesday evening. Scouts have a badge clinic at East Mesa coming up on Saturday, June 1st. Beginning at 9am ending by 2pm. Easter Sunday was eventful. We had 3 Easter Egg Hunts between the 2 locations with 750 eggs and we gave out 60 worship bags to children between the 2 locations. On May 5th we had Richard Wall and John Weber swap locations. Richard played De Colores for the Children so they could sing during worship. Following worship, we had a Cinco De Mayo GIFT (Generations in Fellowship Together) Event where we shared a meal together, learned what Cinco De Mayo was; created piñatas, made maracas, clay pots and sombreros. The weekend of June 1 and 2 we will be celebration all graduates with cake during coffee hour. All Graduates/or promotion students will be asked to stand and receive a blessing. Our High School Graduate will receive a quilt during the 10:30 worship service at East Mesa. Vacation Bible School – To Mars and beyond will be held June 17th – 21st from 5:30pm – 8pm

with a VBS worship service on Sunday, June 23rd at 10:30 at East Mesa. There will be an ice cream social following worship. If you would like to volunteer please email Kim McCracken. Campformation will be July 7th – 12th at Camp Pine Rock. Lutheran Campformation is open to students who are going into 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th Grade. The cost is \$325.00 per person. There was a Discipleship meeting with Pastor Bill, Pastor Tina, Paul Johnson, and Cindy Reichert attending. The Israel Trip (September 2019) has 18 people committed with a possible 27 people total. The Oberammergau Trip- (September 2020) has 48 people firm plus a wait list. The Genesis Bible study will be concluding the end of May. June will be the book of Colossians (4 weeks). July and August will be a study on the Psalms. There will be a possible Bible study from November to March on the Book of Exodus. Bible Studies had good numbers at both EM and GC with up to 70 attending at EM and 20 attending at GC. We will be doing another book study during High Season (Jan- March). The Book Study was also well attended with similar numbers. Dinner Movie and Discussion will take a break for the summer months. We will resume movies in September/October. Our Highest movie was The Shack with 64 people in attendance; our average attendance was about 30, with our lowest at 11 people.

VBS we will be putting a cap on the number of children we will be serving due to the lack of willing adult servants. For a VBS of 100 children between the ages of 4 and 12; at least 40 adult leaders (21+) are needed. Children, Youth and Family Ministry Team will be meeting to discuss the pros and cons of year round Sunday school.

Susan - WELCA – All WELCA circles, except one, will not meet again till September.

John – Music – The organ in the basement that has been sold and will be loaded on a truck going to Denver on Wednesday May 22nd. John will be gone on vacation July 14th and 21st. Ned Potter will be filling in.

Mike – Worship – The summer services will continue to be 4pm, 7:30am, 9am, and 10:30am all year round. Communion will be via Intinction through the summer. Communion will be served all year at the 9am service. All other services will serve communion the first weekend of the month; same as the past. We will move the 4pm & 9am Services to the Chapel from Memorial Day to Labor Day. If attendance at the 7:30 service drops below 60 people for two weekends, the service will go to the Chapel. The 10:30am service will stay in the Sanctuary because of the live streaming. The Easter Paraments (Cross) will be changed on Friday June 7th.

New Business

Ron – There is a request from Harmony care, health screenings, to set up a mobile truck in the Parking lot starting in July for 1 to 2 days per month. Harmony is willing to pay \$250 per day; a donation. They are asking for access to the Church restroom for the attendants during the **screening hours. Harmony's hours are typically 7am to 3pm to 4pm; subject to the number of requests/clients.** Linda moved that we allow Harmony to do this with Dave seconding it. The motion was amended subject to Kim working out the details on where they will park, what entrance the attendants would enter to use the restroom, south or east entrance, and the completion of a MOU. The Committee voted unanimously with the amendments to allow Harmony to **use the parking lot with access to the Church's restroom.**

There was a request to put ropes up in the Sanctuary. There is a policy in place from the EM Coordinating Committee that no ropes will be put up in the Sanctuary; so no ropes.

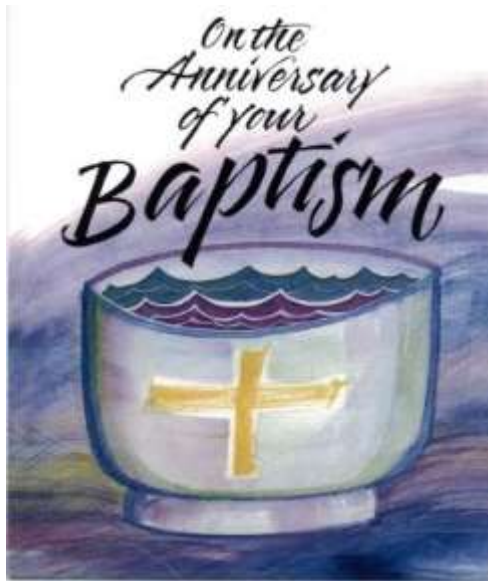
