It really is an adventure that challenges us all to trust in God above all else, no matter what the day's circumstances are screaming.

Like Punxsutawney Phil, we are often dragged blinking out of our comfort zone. Will we be afraid of our shadow? Will we rejoice that there will be six more weeks of winter, or complain that there will be six more weeks of winter? The secret of life is this: we can't change the weather (among many things); we can choose to make the best of it or be a victim of it. Which will it be today?

This is the day that the Lord has made! Will we rejoice and be glad in it?

1. Pr. Bill provided us with an devotion and opened with a prayer.

2. New Business:

a. A motion was made, seconded and passed appointing Janice Cunningham Chairman of the Gold Canyon Coordinating Committee for the next year. This position automatically becomes a member of the church Council for a 3 year period. If another person is appointed as Chairman during this 3 year period, the new chair may choose to ask the current Chair to continue as a member of the Council.

b. Karen Howard reported that the "Snack Pack" school program has used all their funds for this year. A discussion was held as to how the congregation could be encouraged to donate additional funds for this program. Pr. Bill will make an announcement at all services at Gold Canyon this weekend encouraging people to support the "Snack Pack" program. Karen would like to see a regular mission month assigned to the program.

c. Ash Wednesday is March 6th. Soup Suppers will again start on that day and continue until Wednesday, April 10th. A motion was made, seconded and passed for the Free Will Offering to be given to the "Snack Pack" program. Soup will be requested from the following groups:

3. Old Business: Karen Howard had reported that the Christmas Potluck was a successful. Robert Cunningham found a local company that carries the choir steps he is going to order. However, they order from the same distributor and the cost is a bit more. He will order directly from the distributor and have them delivered to his home as they must be signed for. Will take 6-8 weeks. Leonard is still working with Kim to schedule a youth group to paint the parking bumpers.

4. Pastors and Staff

a. Pr. Bill – Christmas services went well. Attendance was up 300 people over last year. He has been in discussions with Bishop Hutterer concerning a seasonal pastor to help us through the high season and allow

time for us to provide some classes. There is no one available. He has also touched bases with some of the retired pastors that attend Our Saviors and found no one who is interested. He and Pastor Tina have been very busy making hospital visits. Carol Gruenwald is the only person in the hospital from Gold Canyon, several of the members at East Mesa make up the rest of the list.

b. Pr. Tina just wanted to thank everyone for their support and flexibility during the last month.

c. Kim McCracken provided a written report.

d. Dave Reurink is meeting with Titan at East Mesa Thursday and will be coming to Gold Canyon after that. He is getting a plumber to work on the toilets in the ladies bathroom in the sanctuary. Two out of four of them are not working correctly. The November water bill showed we used an extra 50,000 gallons of water. He is investigating that and will contact the fire department to see if there is any way to secure the fire connections on the west side of the building.

5. Ministry Chair Reports (only those with current activity are shown below)

a. Administration – Kim Burg is working in the mornings at Gold Canyon on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Mike Johnson is working on Wednesday mornings.

b. Discipleship Suzy Cavoto's report was included with Kim's written report. They meet again tomorrow.

c. Evangelism (Fellowship)– Mike Johnson worked up a report on the cost of advertising in the Gold Canyon area. He will provide it to the Pr. Nancy at their next meeting.

d. Finance – John Malmberg reported that contributions for December were above the Mission Plan but below last year's numbers. The Finance Committee is meeting the 19th to continue working on the 2019 Mission Plan. It will be presented to the Council at the January meeting and at the Congregation Annual Meeting for approval in February. Karen Howard reported that the Audit Committee will conduct the WELCA audit January 10th and the internal audit will be done January 16th.

e. Good News – Mike Johnson said we have a new member and two associate members. Two others have indicated an interest in associate membership.

f. Missions – The mission for October was the Native American Urban Mission Church. The check should be ready soon. Janice and Robert will deliver this check. Everyone was invited to attend. There will be a Mission meeting on November 20th at 1:00pm at East Mesa.

g. Property Team – Leonard suggested a notice of help needed for landscaping work be placed in the bulletin and on the PowerPoint. Janice will see to this.

h. WELCA - Karen Howard said that their monthly bible study and meeting is tomorrow. The Bazaar needs volunteers January 21st to the 25th. The date of the Bazaar is the 25th and 26th.

Our next meeting is Tuesday, February 5, 2019 at 5:30pm.

### Family Promise - Robin

The next Family Promise event is scheduled for February 17-24. Volunteers are needed to help with various aspects of the program, including providing meals and overnight stays.

Motion by Richard, seconded by Linda to bring the amended MOU with Family Promise to Council for approval. Motion passed.

### I-Help - Linda

The I-Help ladies spent Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve and New Year's Day at Our Savior's. Gift bags were donated and given to the women as Christmas gifts. The ladies were very grateful for this special holiday cheer.

### Kitchen – Phyllis

Baked goods will be served during the Bazaar on January 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>. Lenten soup suppers will begin March 13.

### Parking Lot Update– Ron

The parking lot project is moving forward. Soil testing is complete and documentation for the required permits is now at the County for review.

### Property Team – Dave

New kitchen stoves have been installed; concrete extension in the dumpster area is complete; the AC/heater unit in the Community Room will be installed on January 15; bulbs for the outside lights at the East Entrance have been ordered and will be installed upon arrival.

### Discipleship/Youth Activities– Kim

A written report was submitted. Among the items listed were:

The EM Dinner & A Movie, held on January 10, was sparsely attended as it was not advertised **successfully. The Discipleship Team's goal is to provide the selection of movies several months in advance so they may be publicized in a timely manner; the next movie night will be held at Gold Canyon on Thursday, February 14. "The Shack" will be shown; the Angel Tree ministry provided Christmas gifts for 260 children in the East Valley; 4 of our young ladies will be attending Tirosh, a 3 day spiritual retreat, January 19-21; more help is needed to pick fruit on Saturday, January 19<sup>th</sup>; several of our youth assisted members of the congregation to sign up for Amazon and Fry's Rewards. They will also be available at Gold Canyon the weekend of January 19/20 to provide assistance; a schedule of events for 2019 was provided.**
