Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Coming fresh off the annual meeting, I am filled with a sense of gratitude and of challenge. Gratitude for the ways in which the congregation both prepared and **responded to a major threat to our ministry's viability; challenge for what lies before us.**

It is worth pausing to reflect upon what we have just been through. To make things right with the county and protect our neighbors, we were presented with a task that nearly doubled before our eyes. Thank you for your forward planning for a "rainy day", quite literally as well as figuratively. **When we were approached** about the buy-out of our cell tower lease three years ago, little did we know that that money would be needed, but God did. Your generous outpouring of financial and moral support to complete the project is still amazing. Thanks be to God for it all!

The challenge before us comes from the reality that we drained our reserve fund down to \$3,000 from \$270,000; we spent down over \$90,000 of general fund money to be able to complete the repayment of the loan we used for the final payment. While there is a sense of relief and contentment for having it all paid off, we are heading into the new year without the normal reserves we count on to carry us through the summer.

In good Lutheran fashion, we must ask: "What does this mean?"

For one, we bear this challenge together. The ways in which we collectively respond will determine our future trajectory. Because of the faithfulness of God **and the passion you have demonstrated in the past for God's ministries through us to continue, I believe we shall come through this one as well.**

As the song we love to sing states: "tis grace has brought us safe thus far and grace will lead us home."

What a privilege it is to share in this ministry with you, to watch God's grace unfold before our very eyes, and to trust in the future that God is providing.

What does this mean? We can all get on our knees and give thanks to God, while at the same time rolling up our collective sleeves and getting back to work **touching lives and making a difference in God's so-loved world!**

Mike opened with prayer.

Pastor Tina – Sarah McCracken is attending the Triosh three-day youth retreat this weekend. It was suggested that the committee write words of encouragement to her for this retreat. The Committee agreed and a card was passed around to the various committee members to be presented to Sarah.

Mike –There is nothing new on the transfer of the Curtis Swanson House to the Church.

Linda – I-Help – Linda and Robin are sharing the I-Help duties. Everything is going well.

Phyllis – Kitchen – Phyllis is getting ready for the soup suppers for the upcoming Wednesday Lenten season. Soup will be served from 4:50pm to 6:15pm starting on Wednesday 3/4 and ending on Wednesday 4/1.

Pastor Bill – Pi Day will be on Saturday 3/14 and pie will be served. Phyllis will coordinate with Pastor Bill on this. We normally get pies from Village Inn. Two Village Inns have closed and there is only one left in the area. We were due to replace 11 out of date computers. It could have cost \$1000 each. However refurbished computers were purchased that are a lot faster compared to the old models and cost \$300 each. \$3300 vs. \$11,000; this was an excellent use of funds.

Dave – Property – There is a burnt out ceiling light and one ceiling light to adjust in the sanctuary. Dave is looking for a company to pump the septic tank. There are cracks and heaving in the parking lot. Ron and Dave are following up with the company to correct this. There was an upgrade to the electronic sign from 720p to 4K. There was money still left in the sign fund to do this. This upgrade was significant in the display quality and the programming capability.

Kim – Discipleship – On Wednesday 3/4, there will be a quarterly Discipleship Meeting. The Dinner and Movie program **has been successful. This Thursday, the movie “Breakthrough”, will be shown at GC. The Bible Study schedules are listed** in calendar.

Kim – Children, Youth and Family – Seven kids and 2 adults picked fruit this past weekend. There are seven more houses to pick this Saturday and Monday. This past Sunday was Scout Sunday. There was a Coop on projects with the scouts and OSLC youth. There will be a youth group observing the Forge worship service. This was held last year and it was very well attended. Linda moved and Ed seconded that we recommend to the Council to approve this. The Committee voted unanimously to recommend to council for approval. This will be presented at the February Council Meeting for approval.

John – Music – The Resort Choir will be performing at the Saturday Service on 2/29. Glenn Henriksen will be performing on Sunday 3/1 at 2pm in the EM Sanctuary.

Council Action Needed - In the January 2020 EM CC Meeting, it was recommended to the council via a unanimous vote from the EM Coordinating Committee to allow Glenn Henriksen to sell his CDs at the 3/1 concert as he has done in the past. This will be presented to the February Council Meeting for approval.

John is still waiting on a commitment from one of the members of the Easter Brass Group. The 7pm Lenten Service will be held in the Chapel. There is \$5400 in the Chapel Organ Fund that is designated for the updates to the Chapel Organ. An organ technician will be in this week to perform these updates. The updates are needed to improve the functionality of the organ and to make sure the organ controls are in the right spot/position. With these monies, this will complete year two of the three year project. Additional parts for the organ that were sold will be moved out of the basement possibly this Friday morning.

Susan - WELCA – The Winter Potluck will be 2/15 and Crazy Fingers will be the entertainment. The Spring Celebration will be Friday 3/20. Gold Canyon is in charge and will meet 2/11 and 3/11 to finalize plans. The Spring Celebration may be at EM to increase attendance. It was suggested to possibly have a thrift shop fashion show either this year or in the near future. The Rio Salado Gathering is Saturday 3/21 at Spirit of Joy starting at 8:30am. 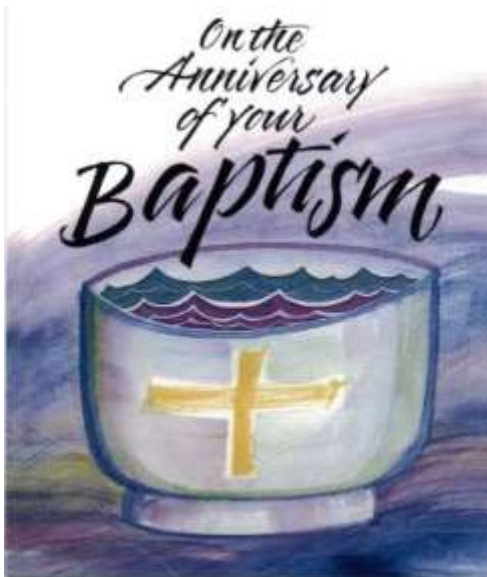

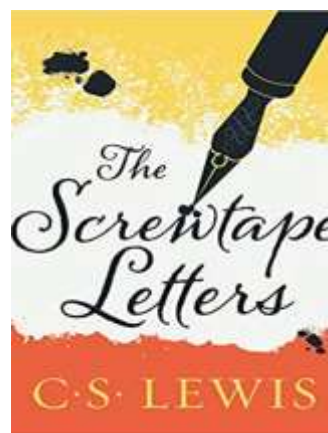

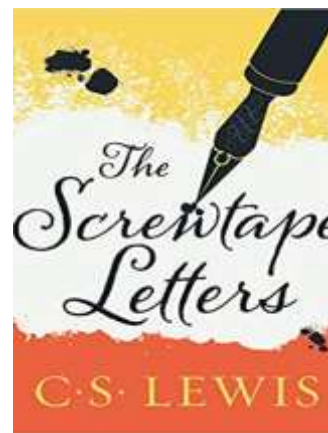
