Years later, they would celebrate a Festival of Booths (Succoth), in which they would set up a tent in the backyard and remember the "good ol' days." While some of you can remember out houses, fetching water from the well, butchering your own chickens, there aren't too many lining up to go back to the "good ol' days."

Have you been more intentional about communicating with family? Are friends and neighbors becoming more familiar to you once again? If these are changes you've experienced on this altered path, please don't go back to the old way.

If you experienced living in a more health rhythm, keep it going.

Sometimes, the unplanned path is the more interesting path. Sometimes things remain the same: God is with you every step of the way; there are always interesting people on the path; and God IS the destination as well as traveling companion.

I'm becoming more comfortable with what I don't know. I'm becoming more comfortable with daily bread and guidance. (This does not mean I am anymore enamored with CoVid-19.)

Soon we will gather again for worship (I don't know when). It will be different (masks, physical distancing, even the way in which we worship). But God's people will be there. We'll continue to figure out life together. We'll continue to serve our neighbors in need. We'll follow God all the way home.

That is enough for me... for today.

DEVOTIONS: Pastor Rindy gave the prayer.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Cindy Reichert moved to accept the May 5, 2020 amended minutes and was seconded by Mike Kraklow. MC

STAFF REPORTS:

Pastor Rindy: 1. Continuing to meet as staff and worship planning. 2. Working with a different video setup at East Mesa. 3. Leaving for ND to see parents on Thursday, May 21. 4. He will bring back the video equipment for East Mesa and Gold Canyon. 5. Learning how to deal with memorial services and people who are hospitalized.

Pastor Mills: 1. Memorial service on June 3 at Mariposa Gardens. 2. Talked with Jackie Pagel from the Synod office – please refer congregation to the Bishop's letter regarding pandemic guideline. Also the pastor's at the Synod office are recording sermons to be used by local Pastors. Recommends using the video from the Presiding Bishop. 3. People are still calling on the phone trees. If there are any questions regarding the opening of the church refer them to the Bishop's letter and that we are following the guidelines of the state and federal governments, CDC and the ELCA.

Kim McCracken: 1. Working on recognition of the graduating seniors. 2. Also working on a schedule of outside groups for the use of our facility after reopening.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Cindy Reichert gave the Treasurer's report. Richard Falk moved to accept the Treasurer's Report. Second by Suzy Cavoto. MC

There has been a revision to the PPP loan. We can no longer include staff who are 1099 (contract workers). Therefore, we will have to return \$22,000 to Chase.

EAST MESA CAMPUS COORDINATING COMMITTEE: 1. Task force is making plans for the reopening of the Church. The task force is recommending using two criteria for the reopening: 1. Based on a majority of the state and federal guidelines, CDC guidelines and the ELCA guidelines. 2. Not to reopen until we can obtain a sufficient amount of PPE (personal protective equipment; masks and wipes) for our worshippers.

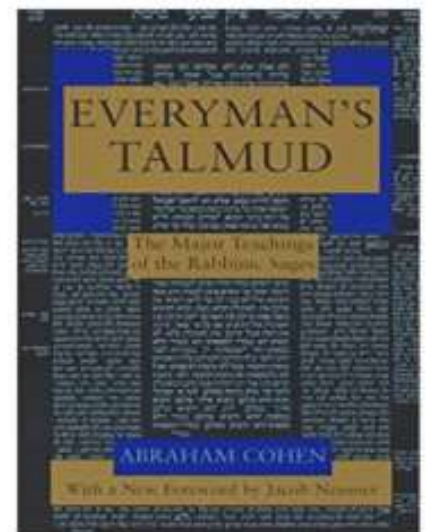
Talmud Time:

13. There are 30 to 40 people attending each of Pastor Bill and Pastor Tina's Bible Studies via Zoom – If interested please contact the Pastors or the office
14. Kim is having Zoom Sunday school and Zoom informational meetings with the youth and others.
15. Linda and Angela are working out of their homes. Calls coming into the church are forwarded to their phones and then they can transfer these calls to the appropriate people. Linda and Angela can work on their home computers via the Church's virtual office network.
16. All other staff are working from their office and/or home
17. Pastor Tina organized 50 + volunteers. These volunteers call anyone who ever attended OSLC recently; call every 2 to 4 weeks asking them how they are doing. The volunteers report anything that is significant to the Pastors.
18. Currently a committee is working on a plan for reopening both campuses with the safety of the congregation and Pastors / staff as the main goal. At this time, we don't know what date both campuses will open.

Virtual Vacation Bible School

Due to practicing physical distancing, Our Savior's will not have an "in person" VBS. However, we will be hosting a Virtual VBS and although we will miss seeing you in person, we hope that you will enjoy the activities we have planned for you!

During our Virtual VBS we will be exploring the Miracles of Jesus through Bible Story Dramas, Crafts, Science and Music.



We will have two live Experiences: one at 9am and one at 6:30pm through Zoom. 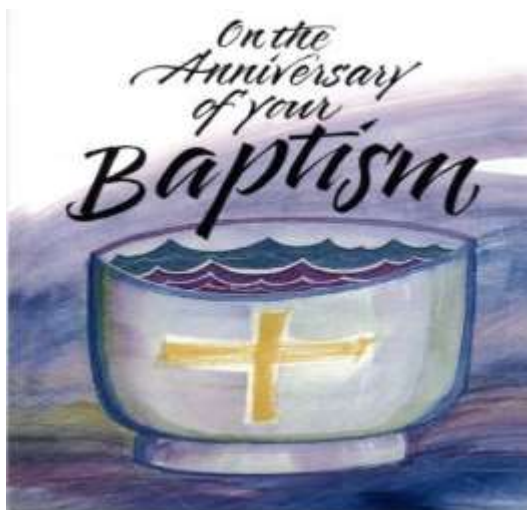
