Pastor Bill will be taking some time this week to travel to North Dakota to visit his parents. He will be at East Mesa on Sunday. 4. Pastor Bill has been talking with a parishioner who wants to deed over her house to the Church. Lawyers are working on this. 5. Bible studies are continuing.

Bible Study on 1 & 2 Samuel

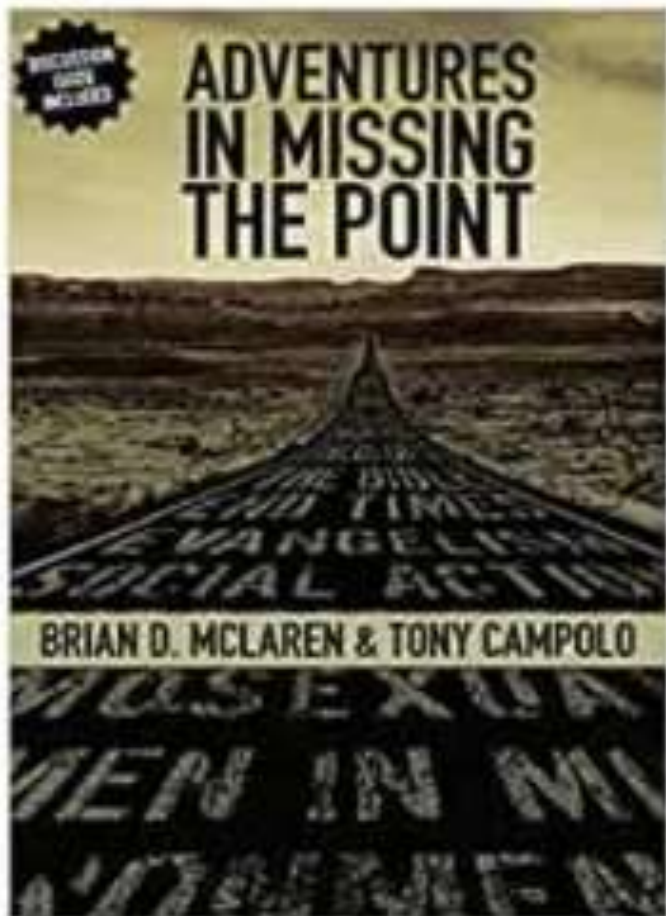

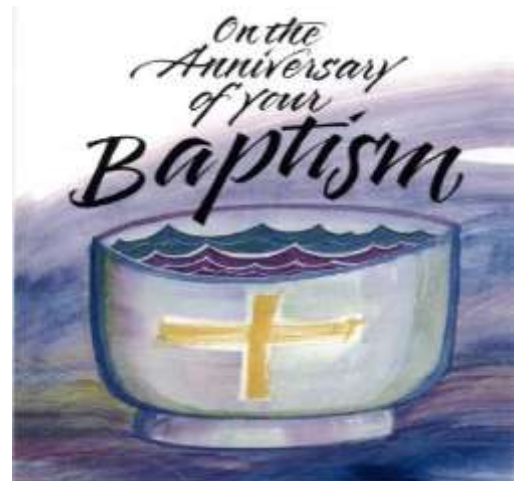
